

St John the Baptist PS Summer School

The summer school will run for 10 school days commencing Wednesday 15th July and ending on Tuesday 28th July. This will be open to current Primary 6 children who will be starting Primary 7 in August.

- Children must enter the school grounds on their own- i.e. adults must remain outside the school gates when dropping off and collecting children.
- Parents and children are asked to maintain social distancing when waiting outside the school.
- P6AB pupils will enter and exit through the Main Gate.
- P6AMcC pupils will enter and exit through the Side Gate on Finaghy Road North (looking directly at P1/P2 classrooms.)
- Children can wear their own clothes for the duration of the summer school.
- The school will run each day from 9.30am until 1pm.
- Pupils should bring a small break with them in a disposable plastic bag each day- strictly no nut based products. Children are permitted to bring one water bottle which they will be required to take home with them each day.
- Parents must wait outside the school gates at 1pm to collect the children.
- Children may be required to bring test papers/pack material into school, but should only do so if requested by the class teacher. Otherwise they should not bring anything to school with them.
