Graduation Ceremonies (P1-P6)

On Friday (25th April), all P1-P6 children will be involved in an SJB Graduation Ceremony in the school to mark the completion of what has been a very unique school year. They will receive specially designed certificates to take home and photographs of the event will be shared on class SeeSaw accounts. Children's Reports

Breakfast, Dinner and After School Clubs next week

As the school canteen is closed on Wednesday, Morning Supervision Club will run instead in the school hall from 7.45am. Parents wishing to avail of these should send in the money as usual on Monday morning (£1.50 Breakfast Club for Mon/Tue and £1 for Morning Supervision on Wed.) Please ensure your child is walked to the school front entrance on Wednesday morning if availing of Morning Supervision. As usual, this facility is only open to parents who have pre-registered.

Final Day of School (Wednesday 30th June)

The final day of school for this term will be next Wednesday. P1/P2 children will leave at 10.55am and all remaining children will leave at 11am. P3/P4 children will exit through the Church Playground exit (their usual entrance/exit point) whilst P5/P6 children will also exit through their usual gates (the Main Gate for P5 and the Side Entrance Gate on Finaghy Road North for P6.)

Return to School Dates

P2-P7 children will return to school for the new academic term on Friday 27th August, with the second day of term being Tuesday 31st August as Monday is a Bank Holiday. Both of these days will be half-days, with exact finish times to follow. We are currently awaiting guidance from the Department of Education in relation to existing Covid measures and whether they must be carried over into the new academic year, so more information will follow in advance of the start of term.
