Included below is a reminder of the summer school details already sent out to parents below.

P5 Summer School Details

- The school will run each day from 10am until 1pm, with a break at 11.30am for 15 minutes.
- P5 Summer school will run from Wednesday 14th July- Tuesday 27th July.
- The children will be involved in a range of activities including art, PE, philosophy as well as some literacy and numeracy lessons.
- Children must enter the school grounds on their own- i.e. adults must remain outside the school gates when dropping off and collecting children.
- Parents and children are asked to maintain social distancing when waiting outside the school.
- Children can wear their own clothes for the duration of the summer school.
- Pupils should bring a small break with them in a disposable plastic bag each day-strictly no nut based products. Children are permitted to bring one water bottle which they will be required to take home with them each day.
- Parents must wait outside the school gates at 1pm to collect the children.
- Children should not have to bring any items with them apart from their break each day.
