# **Return to School**

All children (P2-P7) will return to school on <u>Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> August and Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> August, finishing at 12pm on both days.</u> The pre-existing arrangements for the phasing in of Primary 1 pupils will remain in place (parents/ guardians were provided with the relevant details for their respective children during the June induction meetings in school.) Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> September will be the first full day of school for P2-P7 children. Parents of children enrolled in the Social Communication Units will also be provided with alternative arrangements for the phasing in of children for the new term in the days to come.

- All classes will start at <u>8.55am</u> every morning, with pupils able to enter school grounds from 8.45am before proceeding directly to their classrooms. The entrance and exit points for children of all classes have been outlined in the table, in addition to the end of day times for all classes during the week.
- Parents should note the end of day times, which differ from arrangements in place during the
  pandemic period. All pupils will also end class at 1.30pm on Fridays. We will, however, continue
  with the hand sanitizing operation at the start of the day, subject to a review as the year
  progresses.
- At the end of the school day, the P5, P6 and P7 children will be walked by their teachers to the Finaghy Road North exit points so parents are asked to remain in the car park or on the road until the children arrive.

## **Morning Access Arrangements**

We are fortunate to have large school grounds with multiple entry points, and these will continue to be utilised fully in the morning and afternoon to minimise congestion when children are arriving and exiting school. We will be reinforcing with children the expectation that these arrangements are adhered to at all times and would appreciate your support in this regard. <a href="Punctuality continues to be of paramount importance">Punctuality continues to be of paramount importance</a>, and issues in this regard will be addressed quickly and directly with parents to ensure they are decisively resolved.

<u>Breakfast Club</u> and <u>After School Club</u> provision will be shared with parents in the near future and will require pre-booking once again this year. The clubs will open from Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> September.

#### **School Dinners**

Dinners will be available for all pupils from Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> September, and the dinner menu for the first term has already been shared with parents via text and on the school's website. Dinner money must be paid on the Monday (or first day) of each week in a clearly labelled envelope outlining which days your child will be going to dinners.

#### **School Uniform**

Pupils will continue to wear their school uniform as usual <u>every day</u>. The designated PE Day for each class will be shared with parents early in the term. When that happens, all parents will be informed of the one day each week in which the children are asked to come to school in their appropriate PE uniform.

### **Hand Sanitisation Arrangements & Hygiene**

There will continue to be designated hand sanitisation stations at all entrance points to the school and children and staff will be required to sanitise their hands upon entering the school each morning. This will be subject to review throughout the school year. Parents are asked to ensure that, as a matter of daily routine, children are instructed to wash their hands each morning immediately prior to leaving for the journey to school. Parents are also asked to provide their children with a packet of tissues for their exclusive use in school.

#### **Covid Symptoms**

It remains the case that children exhibiting Covid symptoms must not come to school and parents/guardians are asked to remain vigilance with regard to this throughout the school year.

#### Seesaw

Class Seesaw accounts will be set up during the first week of term and parents/ guardians are asked to ensure that they have set these up appropriately at the earliest opportunity. These provide an effective and direct means of communication which is important in the event of a recurrence of the pandemic-related school closures that have been experienced throughout the preceding three school years. Children will continue to be assigned homework to be completed via Seesaw every Thursday in order to ensure all remain familiar with the method of communication.
