



Breakfast Club & After School Club Arrangements

Breakfast Club

It is our intention to begin a Breakfast Club to commence from Thursday 1st September, opening as usual from 7.45am.

Attendance at the Breakfast Club will be **strictly limited** to a predetermined number of children who have **pre-registered**.

This will operate on a **first come first served basis**, and you will be informed if your child has secured a place in the Breakfast Club.

This is necessary to restrict numbers to an acceptable level consistent with our risk assessment protocol.

The cost for attending the Breakfast Club is £1.50 per day. All payments must be paid on the Monday (or the first school day of each week) in an envelope clearly marking which days the child will be attending the club.

For example, if you only want your child to attend on a Tuesday and Thursday each week, the £3 cost should be paid on Monday and you must label on the envelope that the child will be in the club on those two days only.

The Breakfast Club facility is open **only to P2-P7 pupils** at this time. This will be reviewed at a later point in the academic year and parents informed of changes as they are introduced.

In the event of you deciding that you no longer require a place for your child, please inform the school office (90-614546) so that another child from the anticipated waiting list can avail of a place.

After School Supervision (Monday- Thursday)

From Thursday 1st September, we are opening an after school supervision room for P1, P2 and P3 pupils between 2pm and 3pm from Monday to Thursday. The cost of attendance will be **£6 per week (P1-P2)** and **£4 per week (P3)** and a **pre-registration fee of £5 must also be paid with the first payment**. Parents wishing to secure a place should send the exact amount of money (£5 reg. fee plus £1.50 for Thursday 1st September) in a clearly marked envelope on Tuesday 30th August or Wednesday 31st August with a reference to 'After School club' on it with the child's name and class.

Thereafter, monies for the week (£6 for P1/P2 and £4 for P3 pupils) must be paid in a clearly marked envelope each Monday. Please note: these fees will be in place regardless of days attended each week to cover the cost of subsidizing the club. Amount due each week will continue to be reduced in the event of school holidays/ closures.

There are **a limited number of places** due to the necessity of restricting numbers and places will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. Parents will be informed if they have been successful in securing a place for their child.
